"What to Bring / What Not to Bring"

***IMPORTANT! All visitors MUST bring required identification / documentation on the day of the tour or they will NOT be allowed to participate.**

US citizens: US citizens are required to provide one of the following types of identification (MUST BE CURRENT/NOT EXPIRED):

- Valid DMV Driver's License (cannot be a temporary paper - must have a photo ID)
- Valid DMV Identification Card (cannot be a temporary paper - must have a photo ID)
- Valid US Passport

Non-US citizens: Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory has security requirements that necessitate visitors show proper identification prior to gaining access. As a foreign national, please bring the appropriate original documents from the following list to establish your legal status in the United States in order to gain admittance for your visit.

- A legal Permanent Resident is required to show a valid Permanent Residency Card (green card) or ADIT (Alien Documentation, Identification and Telecommunication) stamp
- A nonimmigrant foreign national must show a current passport with a valid I-94. A nonimmigrant foreign national with an I-94 valid for "duration of status" must also produce the proper supporting documentation indicative of current status (e.g., DS-2019, I-20, EAD, etc.)
- Canadian citizens must provide a valid passport with entry stamp or a valid I-94 to gain access to LLNL.

ALL FOREIGN VISITORS MUST BE IN POSSESSION OF THEIR PASSPORT.

ALL FOREIGN VISITORS (EXCEPT CANADIAN) MUST HAVE AN I-94

VISA TYPE F1: MUST BRING I-20

VISA TYPE J1: MUST BRING DS-2019

Failure to provide appropriate documentation will result in denied access to the site. There are no exceptions.

Prohibited items: You are not allowed to bring backpacks, briefcases, packages, cell phones, pagers, tape recorders, any electronic transmitting or receiving devices, cameras, binoculars, telescopes, alcoholic beverages, firearms or other weapons, explosives, illegal or unlawfully possessed drugs, and no poisonous or corrosive solids, liquids, or gases. All handbags are subject to an inspection.
